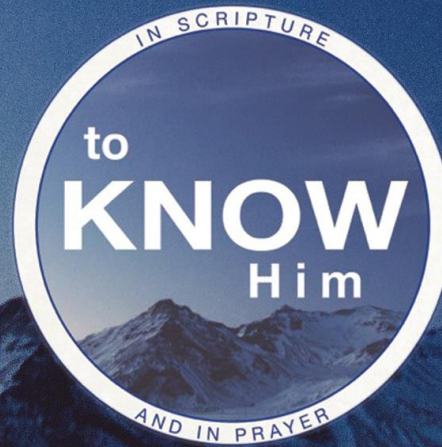

## ***KAC Prayer Diary - September 2020***

### **Tuesday, 1 September 2020**

Pray for each of us at KAC in our relationship with God; that we would be reading the Bible and praying regularly as we seek to know God more and more.

***“In the morning, O Lord, you hear my voice; in the morning I lay my requests before you and wait in expectation.” Psalm 5:3***

### **Wednesday, 2 September 2020**

Pray for Mike as he prepares to preach God’s word at KAC this Sunday. Pray that God will teach Mike from His word and enable him to teach it faithfully to others.

### **Thursday, 3 September 2020**

Pray that God in his mercy might intervene and end the coronavirus pandemic – pray for a deepening trust in God for our brothers and sisters in Victoria, in parts of Sydney and other parts of the world where lives and livelihoods have been turned upside down. Pray for God’s wisdom for our health care workers and scientists developing effective vaccine and treatments.

### **Friday, 4 September 2020**

Commit to prayer our Archbishop, Glenn Davies and our Regional Bishop, Gary Koo. Give thanks for their godly leadership.

### **Saturday, 5 September 2020**

Give thanks for ongoing negotiations between Pete McCutchen and Corrections PNG to do live streaming training in work upskilling and evangelism training to people in prison in PNG.

### **Sunday, 6 September 2020**

Pray and give thanks to God for our dads this Father’s Day.

### **Monday, 7 September 2020**

Pray for Compassion and the safety of local staff and church workers across the globe as they distribute food and meet with mothers and babies in their homes. Pray that God would bring peace amidst the fear that COVID-19 is causing in the community and that children and their families would know God’s love for them.

### **Tuesday, 8 September 2020**

Give thanks for all who serve in various ministries at KAC. Pray that each one would use whatever gift/s they have received to serve others, faithfully administering God’s grace in its various forms.

### **Wednesday, 9 September 2020**

Pray for Christians in our community who may be struggling with addictions of any kind. Pray for repentance, healing, and strong and sensitive Christian support networks.

### **Thursday, 10 September 2020**

Pray for our non-Christian family and friends. Pray for wisdom and courage in taking opportunities to bring them closer to Jesus.

**Friday, 11 September 2020**

Pray for all of us as we strive to consistently live out our KAC mission statement.

**Saturday, 12 September 2020**

Give thanks to God for Jesus dying on the cross in our place for our sins, so that we can receive His free forgiveness and have eternal life if we trust in Him.

**Sunday, 13 September 2020**

Pray for our KAC members as we slowly return to church. Pray that people will be safe and feel welcomed and included.

***"For our life is a matter of faith, not sight" 2 Corinthians 5:7***

**Monday, 14 September 2020**

Pray that persecuted Christians across the world will persevere in following Jesus. Pray for their persecutors; that they will repent and trust in Jesus. Pray for those unable to flee due to the COVID situation.

**Tuesday, 15 September 2020**

Pray for the upcoming US elections as decisions are made which will affect countries across the world, including Australia. Pray for the election candidates; for strength to choose integrity in both their campaigns and their terms in office.

**Wednesday, 16 September 2020**

Give thanks for the ministry of Alan and Helen Wood with CMS in Jakarta. Pray for them as they transition to retirement this month.

**Thursday, 17 September 2020**

Pray for the new people who have joined our church during this season, that they will feel warmly welcomed and make friends and feel a part of our church.

**Friday, 18 September 2020**

Pray for Evangelism Explosion as it struggles to train people at a time when people cannot meet.

**Saturday, 19 September 2020**

Pray for young Aboriginal Christians in the Broome area to grow in their trust of Jesus and to be bold in obeying His word. Pray that God will raise up godly and capable Aboriginal Christians to teach the Bible and be leaders in Kimberley churches.

**Sunday, 20 September 2020**

Praise God for the re-launch of our Sunday services and for the ability to gather as His people once again.

**Monday, 21 September 2020**

Anglicare At Home (AAH) provides physical, social, emotional and spiritual care for carers and for older people who choose to remain in their own homes as they age. Give thanks for this service which empowers older people to stay in their homes and supports carers to achieve this goal. Pray for more older people to connect with the Social & Wellness Centres, particularly during COVID isolation.

**Tuesday, 22 September 2020**

Pray for protection, especially for those amongst us who are sick and vulnerable to infection and for those who are feeling anxiety.

*" Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7*

**Wednesday, 23 September 2020**

Give thanks that we enjoy religious and political freedom in this country. Pray for our Prime Minister, Scott Morrison and Premier, Gladys Berejiklian; that they will seek to do what is right by all citizens.

**Thursday, 24 September 2020**

Anglicare's 13 prison chaplains go into correctional institutions and take Jesus' message of forgiveness with them. Give thanks for this ministry and pray for chaplains as they bring Jesus' counter-cultural message of redemption and hope to inmates, families and staff. Pray for prayer partnerships with churches and for more opportunities to support people within the justice system.

**Friday, 25 September 2020**

Praise God for our small group leaders at KAC. Pray for wisdom and strength as they seek to guide and disciple their small groups this term.

**Saturday, 26 September 2020**

Pray for those in our congregation who are sick or suffering in some way at this and for expectant mums in our congregation. Pray particularly for Donne and Nick as they await the birth of their new baby in September.

**Sunday, 27 September 2020**

Pray for safety on our roads as many people travel during the school holidays.

**Monday, 28 September 2020**

Commit to prayer our Parish Councilors as they meet this evening. Pray for wisdom and graciousness in their discussions.

**Tuesday, 29 September 2020**

Give thanks for our music, sound and projection teams as they seek to maximise their gifts to magnify Jesus.

**Wednesday, 30 September 2020**

Pray for Year 12 students who are beginning HSC examinations next month; for good recall of information learned and for minimal stress and anxiety.
